



“*Runes*” or the “*Runic Alphabet*” is a writing system that was developed by Germanic peoples around the 1st century CE (1-100CE).

It is also known as the “*futharc*” which is a word made up of the first six letters (runes) of the “*Runic alphabet*”.

The word “*alphabet*” itself is similar. It comes from the Greek alpha (A) and beta (B), the first two letters of our alphabet.

RUNES

Each individual rune represented a thing, or a concept as well as a sound. Runes were also considered magic, and used for curses, charms and fortune telling. The Norse believed that knowledge of the runes was a gift to humans from Odin.

Today scholars believe that the runes were probably borrowed from the Latin alphabet.
